




In line with previous board direction and in order to expedite proposal packages for consideration by the board, Proposal 2A-Revision 1 with Technical Corrections includes the correction of city splits in unpopulated areas. The U.S. Census Bureau misassigned three (3) census blocks to the City of Tustin that are actually in the City of Santa Ana with a total of 260 population. Since the affected area is fully assigned to District 4, no correction is necessary.

Because this is a special tabulation of data and not part of the standard data products shown on the Census Bureau's data.census.gov website, these estimates are rounded. Therefore, individual categories may not exactly add to the total.

For example, the sum of each of the race groups for non-Hispanics may not be the same as the estimate given for non-Hispanics. These estimates will not match counts from the 2020 Census.

The original data source for the Citizen Voting Age Population (CVAP) is the American Community Survey (ACS). The ACS is an ongoing survey by the U.S. Census Bureau sent to approximately 250,000 households each month.

The ACS estimates used to develop these data were collected from January 1, 2015 to December 31, 2019 utilizing the 2010 Census block groups, which were disaggregated to the 2020 Census blocks by the Statewide Database.

### Plan Objectives

Creates an inclusive defensible VRA complaint map and ensures all regions of Orange County are fairly represented."

### Notes:

In line with previous board direction and in order to expedite proposal packages for consideration by the board, Proposal 2A-Revision 1 with Technical Corrections includes the correction of city splits in unpopulated areas. Unpopulated census block 060590755163000 in Tustin was reassigned from District 2 to District 3 to eliminate unpopulated split for City of Tustin. Unpopulated census block 060590740031021 in Irvine was reassigned from District 4 to District 2 to eliminate unpopulated split for City of Irvine.

Nine unpopulated census blocks that the U.S. Census Bureau assigned to the City of Santa Ana are actually in the City of Costa Mesa per the OC Surveyor city boundary. These were assigned by author to District 2 so that all Costa Mesa is in District 2 per the OC Surveyor boundary. One unpopulated city split of Santa Ana was removed, leaving two populated splits of the City of Santa Ana.
